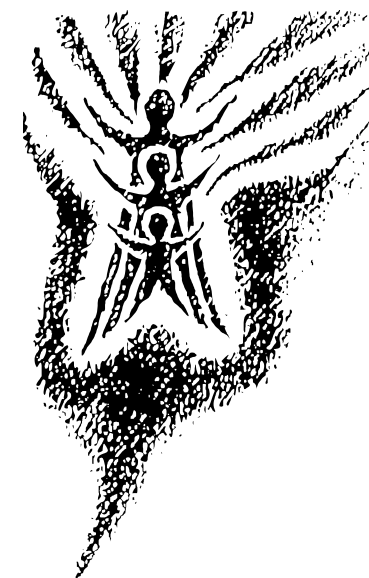

FEE AND CHARGES INFORMATION

(Subject to alteration)

APPLICATION FEE

In order to register a student for enrolment, an Application Form must be completed and a fee of \$80.00 (inc GST) is paid. This fee is non-refundable and covers the administration costs associated with enrolments and interviews. Payment of the application fee does not guarantee a place in the school.

ENROLMENT FEE

When a vacancy becomes available and following a successful interview with the Class Teacher or delegate, an offer of a place at the school may be issued. On acceptance of the offer an enrolment fee, for each child, is to be paid. This is a non refundable fee to confirm your place in the school.

YEAR LEVEL CHARGES

A non refundable year level charge will be charged to cover incidental charges that arise during the year and incidental resource needs.

EURHYTHMY SHOES

Kindy 5 to Class 6 students attend Eurhythmy lessons. The school will provide soft shoes for each student. During the year these shoes may be exchanged for larger shoes as feet grow. These shoes remain the property of the school.

TEXT BOOKS AND PE

Stationery items and PE activities may be charged to school accounts from time to time.

BOOKLISTS

Booklists are sent out before the start of the year. Booklist items are to be supplied by parents.

MEMBERSHIP FEE OF ASSOCIATION

All families with children enrolled in the school (with the exception of playgroup) must be members of the School Association and the fee for this will be charged with the first term fees. Parents will receive any Association newsletters, the weekly Pabulum and be entitled to attend, put forward business and vote at the Annual General Meeting. The Association Fee of \$96.00 per family (GST inc) is payable each year. The school pays a subscription per child to AISWA and SEA from the Association Fee.

FAMILY PARTICIPATION

Families are to submit the F.P.S. Form showing 10 hours of participation each semester. A \$100 charge is made to the family account if the form is not returned by the due date.

CAMP FEES

From Class 4 onwards students participate in annual class camps. Camps are an integral and compulsory part of the curriculum. Exceptions will only be made with a valid Medical Certificate. The cost of camps is not included in the tuition fee and therefore a separate charge is made. The food component of camps is subject to GST.

MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

All primary school students are expected to purchase personal recorders, supplied by the school and billed to your account. Cost is \$90.00 (inc GST). All students in Classes 4-10 receive small group tuition in a musical instrument. Parents are responsible for the hire or purchase of the musical instrument played.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

Notice, in writing, of at least one (1) full term in advance and two (2) terms for Class 6 students must be given prior to the withdrawal of a student. In default, one term's tuition fee is payable. Notice of withdrawal should be given in writing to the School Administrator.

HOLDING OF PLACES

If a parent intends to withdraw a child for **one term only** and wishes to retain the child's place, the full tuition fee will be charged. A request for permission must be made to the School office prior to being absent.

If a child is withdrawn part way through a term full fees are payable for that term. Under no circumstances are any term fees refunded or discounted.

BUILDING LEVY & FUND

The levy which is directly paid into the building fund is charged per family with children attending full time. This supports the schools infrastructure growth and development.

Contributions from parents and friends to the building fund make it possible for the school to expand and develop facilities. All donations over \$2.00 to the Building Fund are tax-deductible. At present \$400 per family is billed to the School account each year in Term One.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE & AMBULANCE COVER

The school has limited insurance to cover students for accidents etc therefore we strongly encourage all parents to take out personal cover for their child/children.

BURSARIES

From time to time families may be unable to meet their fee commitments due to unforeseen circumstances. Temporary limited assistance may be available to these families.

Application for fee assistance is to be made to the School Administrator via the School Bursar on a strictly confidential basis. Final approval rests solely with the School Council. For further information contact the School Bursar.

PAYMENT OF FEES

All fees are due on or before the SECOND FRIDAY OF EACH TERM. Failure to meet fee obligations may result in your child's place not being secure. While it is clearly the Parent/Guardians responsibility to honour their fee commitment, we are aware difficulties can arise. Should this happen, it is expected that immediate contact is made with the Bursar so alternative fee payments can be agreed on.

Please note, any such arrangements made will only apply to the current school year and must be re-negotiated at the beginning of each consecutive year.

Payment methods include BPOINT (credit card/online payment), cash, cheque, eftpos and direct debit payments. Direct debit facilities must be arranged through your own bank.

LATE PAYMENT OF FEES

Parents/Guardians who are unable to pay fees by the due date must notify the Bursar. A late payment fee of \$25.00 per term is charged on accounts, which have not been paid in full by the due date and do not have an approved fee payment arrangement.

Collection costs (including, but not limited to, court fees and charges, legal fees, and agent's commissions) associated with action taken for the recovery of outstanding fees will be charged to fee accounts.

The School reserves the right to deny entry to any child into the next term if fees are outstanding.
