Perth Waldorf School 14 Gwilliam Drive Bibra Lake 3.15pm on Wednesday 2 December in Seeker's Place

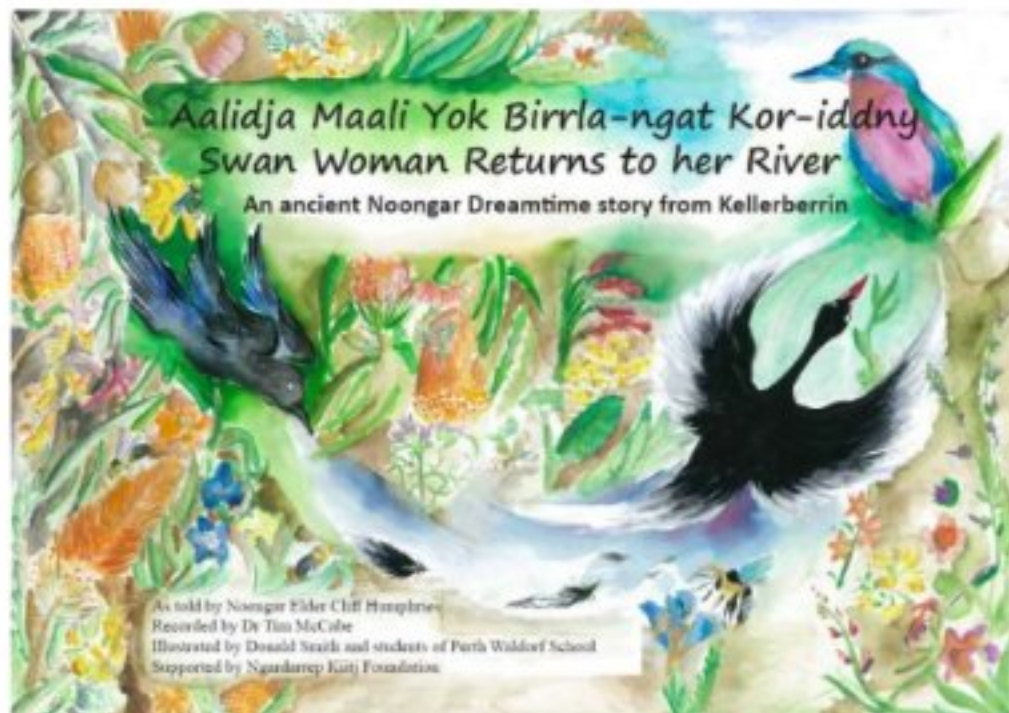
to celebrate the launch of a historic book
