#### **About Us:**

Parkerville Steiner College is a vibrant and growing campus of Perth Waldorf School that currently offers Years 7 to 9 Steiner high school classes. The school is expanding each year to offer the full Year 7 –12 Steiner curriculum by 2027. Steiner Education offers a holistic and creative approach to education that is tailored to meet the developmental needs of young minds, fostering trust and respect between students and staff. At Steiner schools, we value a humanistic approach, focusing on building relationships with students and moving away from the trend of teaching through technology.

#### **The Role:**

As a Maths and Science Teacher, you will be teaching a range of Maths and Science Main Lessons to Years 8 to 10 students. Main Lessons, unique to Steiner schools, are an experiential and in-depth 2-hour morning lesson, where students are given the opportunity to immerse themselves in the subject matter over 15 – 20 days straight. You have an opportunity to develop a deeper relationship with the students and subject matter through this intense 3 to 4 week Main Lesson process.

As well as teaching Main Lesson, the role includes the weekly teaching of Maths as a subject lesson to Years 7 to 10, where there is a focus on building fundamental Maths skills. In addition to the weekly Maths lessons, you will teach Year 10 Science lessons.

#### **What We're Looking For:**

We're seeking a relatable person with an ability to work well with both students and colleagues. You will have a strong Maths and Science subject knowledge but more importantly you will have a love for your subject and for teaching young people. The ability to organise the logistics of setting up and running a science program in a growing campus is also desirable. You should be excited about engaging with the Steiner Curriculum and embodying our school ethos. You will have the chance to foster personal growth in our students through collaborative efforts with other staff members.
